

***The Power and Omniscience of Jesus***  
***Matthew 17:14-28***

**Introduction:** *Today we are coming again to the subject of \_\_\_\_\_.*

**I. If your faith is lacking, \_\_\_\_\_ people lose out.**

**V. Now; two things need to be noted.**

A. This was not the same as the sort of tax that \_\_\_\_\_ collected.
