I'm really looking forward to Christmas this year. I think a lot of people are. Even though it will look very different than years past. There's something about Christmas that provides a sense of familiarity and normality in the midst of a world that's pretty ABnormal right now. Hearing Christmas music, seeing a nativity scene, and watching people put up decorations just seems to have a calming and comforting effect right now.

With so much uncertainty in the world, it's good to be reminded of the truth that never changes—that God so loved the world that He sent His Son. Even if some of the trappings of Christmas are different this year—maybe you're doing your shopping online instead of in stores; we aren't going to be able to have quite as many of our Christmas events as we normally have at church; maybe your family won't all be able to get together—the message Christmas brings is still the same.

And that promise of peace on earth seems to mean a little more when the world around us seems more chaotic.

Our Online Bible Study will finish the year looking at Matthew's account of Jesus' death and burial, and we'll begin the new year by looking at the new life Jesus brought us through His resurrection. But I think it's appropriate that we got to this point in our study at Christmas. Because it reminds us of why Jesus was born in Bethlehem so long ago. He was born to die—for us. And that promise gives us a hope that can't be dimmed by a pandemic or any of the chaotic circumstances around us. "For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord."
